

Product Steering Committee Charge

ReCAP and its partner institutions have developed a middleware that manages the consortium's shared collection program. The Product Steering Committee is responsible for the continued design and direction of the ReCAP middleware. Comprised of two stakeholders from each partner plus a representative from ReCAP, the Product Steering Committee will review changes to the system, discuss product problems and concerns, and advise on overall direction and management of the product. Members of the committee are expected to liaise with other stakeholders from their home institutions so that development is well informed.

The Product Steering Committee will:

1. Advise the ReCAP Executive Director and board on the direction and needs of the middleware product
2. Review, scope, and prioritize new development requests
3. Ensure that ReCAP is in compliance with individual institutional policies (such as those related to GDPR).
